
Blood donation camp was conducted in VMCH on 9/12/22. Around 20 units of blood has been collected.

By sending brochure and talking with patients, advertisement was done for this camp 1 week prior. The healthy volunteers were selected based on certain criteria: Age should be between 18 -60 yrs of both gender, weight should be more than 50 kgs and Hemoglobin should be more than 12.5 gm/dL. They should not have taken alcohol for 24 hrs prior, should not have diabetes, hypertension, allergic to drugs and any other illnesses. They should not have vaccinated recently for rabies, tetanus and hepatitis B.

The selected healthy volunteers for blood donation were asked to fill blood donor form as a token of informed consent and were asked to take breakfast and come for blood donation. 350 ml of blood was taken in a CPD-A bag and then the blood was stored after screening for HIV, VDRL, Hepatitis-B, C and malaria.
