CARDIO PULMONARY RESUSCITATION HANDS ON TRAINING.

According to American Heart Association CPR – or Cardiopulmonary Resuscitation – is an emergency lifesaving procedure performed when the heart stops beating. Immediate CPR can double or triple chances of survival after cardiac arrest. Students of Pharm.D III Year were taken to VELS Medical College & Hospital, Uthukkottai Taluk situated at Tiruvallur district for a hands on training for Cardio Pulmonary Resuscitation. The students were first given a questionnaire sheet in which they were asked to answer few MCQ questions related to CPR before commencing the CPR training to test their existing knowledge about CPR. Dr.Sasikumar then explained about the steps involved before starting CPR. He then meticulously taught how to observe CAB (Compression, Airway, Breathing) and things to pay attention to while performing CPR.
