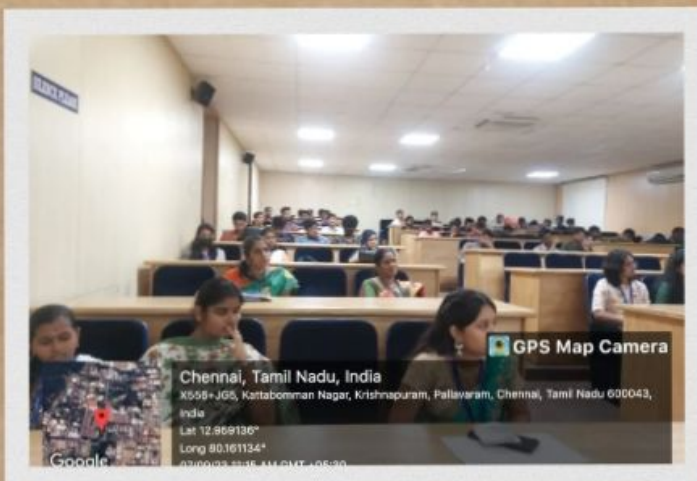




# HINDI DAY -2023
