


RURAL & URBAN HEALTH TRAINING PROGRAMS

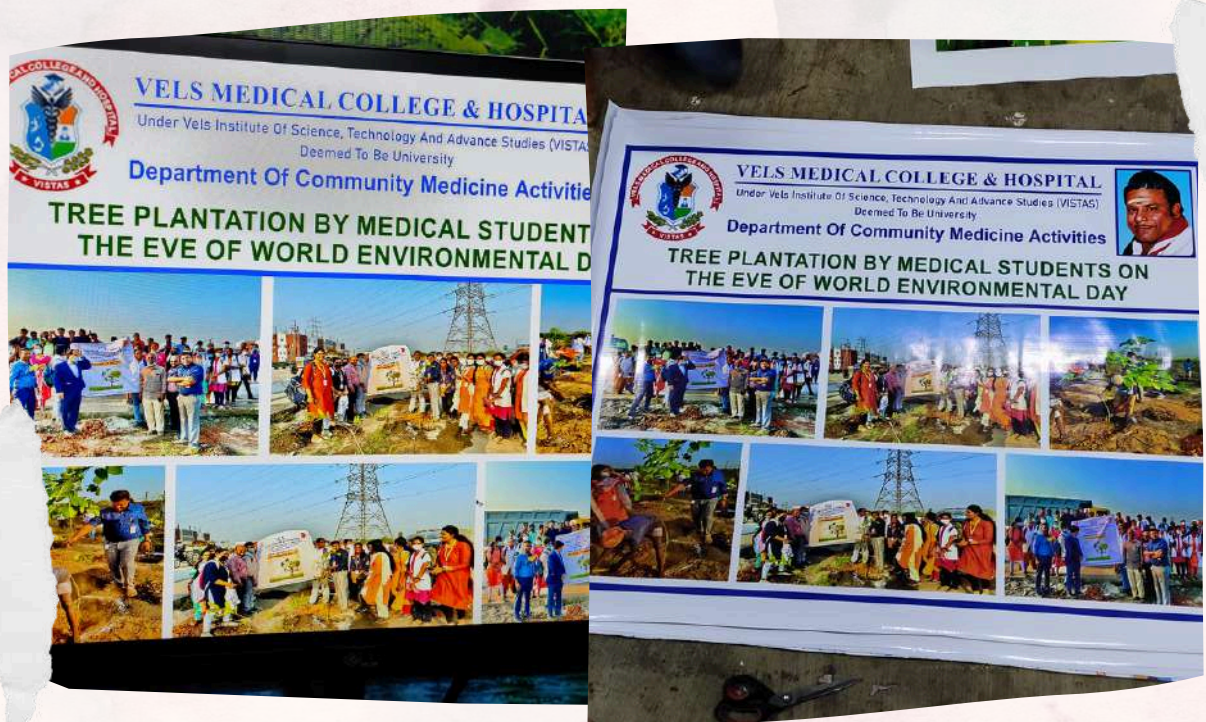

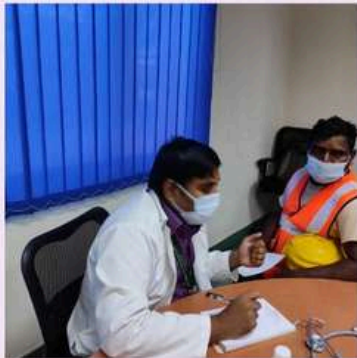
